Thank you for your correspondence of 28 October 2021 providing Coroner Jenkin's Finding following the Coronial inquest into the death of Mr Ly Minh Tong.

The Western Australia Police Force advise all recommendations in the Finding have been accepted and are being progressed as follows.

Recommendation 1 has been allocated to the Professional Standards portfolio to review and amend the policy on the Use of Interpreters to incorporate the Coroner's recommendation.

Recommendation 2 has been allocated to the Professional Standards portfolio to continue amendments which commenced in response to an earlier recommendation by Coroner Jenkin in January 2021. The State Crime portfolio will update the appropriate policies and guidelines in order to incorporate the recommendation.

Recommendation 3 has been allocated to the Specialist and Support Services portfolio to work in conjunction with the Metropolitan Region portfolio to explore appropriate mediums to provide all current frontline staff information regarding the roles and capabilities of the Tactical Response Group and the Regional Operations Group. Additional training became part of the standard curriculum to recruits commencing on 12 November 2021.
